ADMISSION TO THE COLLEGE

Students are admitted to the College as a DECLARED STUDENT to earn a degree or certificate, as a DIPLOMA student to earn an Adult High School diploma, or as an UNDECLARED STUDENT to gain job skills or personal enrichment. Each student must:

- (1) Submit complete health records to the Student Health Center
- (2) Establish their residency status for tuition purposes.
- (3) Complete applications as required. All students are admitted to the College and are permitted to register for classes on a space available basis only.

TUITION RATES

All students are obligated to pay for registered courses unless they officially drop a course(s) on or before August 22, 2005.

RESIDENT STUDENT:.....\$50.00 PER SEMESTER HOUR

A "Resident Student" is a student who makes his/her permanent home on Guam and pays Guam income taxes or is claimed by someone who pays Guam income taxes. Active duty military personnel and their dependents are classified as "Resident Students".

NONRESIDENT STUDENT:.....\$75.00 PER SEMESTER HOUR

A "Nonresident" is a student who makes his/her permanent home away from Guam and does not pay Guam income taxes.

FOREIGN STUDENT:.....\$100.00 PER SEMESTER HOUR

A "Foreign Student" is a non-citizen who holds a non-immigrant visa, e.g., A,B,C,D,F,H,J,L, or M visa.

All students enrolling for the FALL **2005** semester will be classified as a resident, nonresident, or foreign student for tuition purposes when they register for classes. When the College is unsure of a student's residency classification, the College will assess the higher tuition rate. The burden of showing that the residence classification should be changed is on the student and must be provided during the semester in question. The Residence Classification Policy and Procedures of the College are available for inspection at the Office of the Registrar.

PLACEMENT TESTS

English and Mathematics Placement Tests will be given on **April 16, 2005; May 14, 2005; June 18, 2005; July 16, 2005 (for Fall)**, at 7:45am in **Bldg. C, Rm. C-22**. Placement Test is required for enrollment in English and Mathematics classes at the college level. There is a \$15 non-refundable fee charged. Call 735-5562 for details.

TUITION AND FEES

Payment in full of all current tuition and fees and outstanding obligations is required. Payment may be made in cash, by personal check, American Express, VISA or MASTERCARD.

Tuition is charged per credit hour for all credit courses: \$50.00, \$75.00 or \$100.00 (courses numbered 050-299); no tuition is charged for Basic Education courses (courses numbered 000-049). Registration Fee is \$15.00. Student I.D. Card Fee is \$5.00. Library Fee is \$10.00. Student Activity Fee is \$10.00. Health Fee is \$10.00. Student Parking Fee is \$10.00. Technology fee is \$50.00 (\$25.00 for current operations; \$25.00 set aside in a special fund to systematically upgrade computer lab, software, and other technology-related student services). Total \$110.00 (only includes the fees per semester and not tuition, laboratory fees, and textbooks/supplies). Citizens over 55 years of age do not pay tuition and fees; proof of age may be required. REGISTRATION STEPS:

- PICK UP FORMS** - At the Student Services & Administration Building or on our web site: www.guamcc.edu. All students must provide complete health records before they register for classes.
- TURN IN HEALTH RECORDS** - At the Student Health Center.
- COURSE APPROVAL** - Continuing Students -See Advisor. New Students -See a Counselor at the Student Services & Administration Building.
- REGISTER FOR COURSES** - All students must process their ADD/DROP form with the Admissions & Registration staff in the Reception Area of the Student Services & Administration Building.
- PAY FOR COURSES** - At the Cashier's Office in the Student Services & Administration Building.
- BUY BOOKS** - At the GCC bookstore.

LATE FEE

The College will charge a \$25.00 Late Fee if a student fails to make full payment by the designated deadlines. The College will not charge the Late Fee if:

- A student registers only for non-credit courses, special courses, or open-entry courses, or
- A student registers at mid-semester for courses that begin at mid-semester, or
- A student adds a course during Add/Drop dates to replace a cancelled course on or before the Last Day to Add a Class.

The Late Fee is a non-refundable fee.

REFUND POLICY

For **FALL 2005**, the "Regular Semester" refund policy will be applied as follows to courses offered:

Semester Long Courses:

- If a course is dropped on or before August 22, 2005, 100% of the tuition, special fees and laboratory fees will be refunded.
- After August 22, 2005, no refunds will be made for semester long courses.
- The Registration Fee, Late Fee, and Student I.D. Card Fee are not refundable.

Full (100%) refunds of tuition and all special fees and laboratory fees will be made by the College to students whose classes are cancelled by the College provided that the students do not choose to enroll in other courses requiring special fees or laboratory fees. In instances where all of the student's classes are cancelled by the College and the student chooses not to enroll in other classes, the College will also refund the registration fee. Refunds will be mailed to the student during the **Fall 2005** Semester. All requests for refunds are initiated at the Student Services & Administration Building by dropping or withdrawing from classes on or before the due date within the current semester.

RETURN CHECK POLICY

If a student makes payment for tuition and fees using a check, and the check is returned, the student will be contacted by the GCC's Business Office informing him or her of the returned check. Once contacted, the student must pay the amount of the check in full by cash or cashier's check within 48-hours of notice. Additionally, a \$25 returned check fee will be assessed. A \$25 late fee may also be assessed. If a student fails to make payment, he or she may be disenrolled from courses and will be referred to a collection agency.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Financial assistance is available for students at GCC. Types of financial assistance available include Pell Grants, privately funded scholarships and loans, and VA Education Benefits. Applications for any of these types of financial assistance can be obtained by stopping by the Financial Aid Office in Room 2116, Student Services & Administration Building or by calling 735-5543/4. In general, a student may be eligible for assistance if:

1. Student demonstrates financial need
2. Student maintains satisfactory progress toward declared program of study
3. Student is admitted as a Declared Student
4. Student is a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen
5. Student, as required by Federal Law, attests to his/her Selective Service status

In order to receive any form of assistance, the student must comply with the following list of requirements:

1. Complete all necessary forms and documents on or before the established deadlines
2. Be admitted as a **DECLARED STUDENT** and have a declared program of study
3. Enroll in courses required by the program of study
4. Maintain academic **SATISFACTORY PROGRESS**
5. Inform the Financial Aid Office of any changes that might affect the financial assistance and/or educational benefits
6. Comply with all other policies established by the Financial Aid Office

Students who fail to comply with the requirements listed above may jeopardize their assistance and/or educational benefits.

FOREIGN STUDENTS

All foreign students must have a valid status. All foreign students will be required to show their I-94 before being permitted to register for classes. All full-time (I-20) foreign students must obtain a Counselor's or an Advisor's approval of their program of study for the **FALL 2005** semester before they register.

PROOF OF CITIZENSHIP/PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS/STUDENT STATUS

All students may be required to provide documentary evidence of their citizenship. Permanent Resident Aliens may be required to show their Alien Registration Card as they register.

SERVICES FOR STUDENTS WITH A DISABILITY

Students with special needs can be provided with assistance to pursue their academic/vocational goals. Most of the College's instructional and other facilities are readily accessible by disabled students.
